

**FOOTBALL FEDERATION AUSTRALIA TERMS OF ACCREDITATION  
FOR ACCREDITATION PASS HOLDERS**

By accepting and using the accreditation pass (**Accreditation**) issued to you by Football Federation Australia Limited ACN 106 478 068 (**FFA**), you agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions (**Agreement**):

**Terms of Use**

1. You must comply with all terms of this Agreement and any applicable Terms of Admission to the Venue as prescribed by FFA from time to time, to the extent that those Terms of Admission do not directly conflict with the rights granted in your Accreditation (for example, players and team officials may be permitted to enter the field of play notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Terms of Admission).
2. The Accreditation is issued to you personally and cannot be loaned, transferred, assigned or licensed to any other person.
3. The Accreditation is, and remains at all times, the property of FFA. FFA may suspend or revoke Accreditation at any time.
4. The Accreditation must be maintained in good condition and it must not be altered, damaged or destroyed. You must immediately return Accreditation upon FFA's request.
5. The Accreditation must be worn and prominently displayed at all times while in the Venue, other than when your role at the Match prevents you from doing so (such as players on the field and television presenters on camera) or as otherwise provided for in FFA's Events and Venue Operations Policies and Procedures.
6. Depending on your role, a further condition of access (such as wearing an FFA supplied bib) may be imposed on access to certain Accreditation Zones (such as field of play).
7. You will gain entrance to the Venue (and a zone within the Venue) only with your ticket (if applicable) and on presentation of valid Accreditation and, if requested by Venue staff, proof of identity.
8. The terms of Accreditation set out on your Accreditation pass must be complied with at all times (including in relation to which parts of the Venue you are permitted to access in accordance with the schedule to this Agreement (**Accreditation Zones**)). If you fail to comply with this term, FFA may, at its discretion, immediately revoke Accreditation.
9. Accreditation does not permit you to attend a Match as a spectator or to occupy any seat, corporate or members' facility in the stadium that would normally be covered by a ticket or membership.
10. You must comply with the directions of FFA staff whilst in and around the Venue on Match day.
11. FFA may at any time issue further directions, conditions and policies relating to Accreditation and access to the Venue, which you must comply with.
12. You must not:

- (a) carry or wear any political, promotional, advertising or other commercial material of whatever nature (other than material approved by FFA), which is visible at the Match; or
  - (b) conduct yourself in a manner which brings FFA, the Match or football into disrepute.
- 13. You agree to comply with FFA's applicable rules and regulations (including the National Code of Conduct and Spectator Code of Behaviour available at [www.ffa.com.au](http://www.ffa.com.au)) and any Venue conditions of entry, to the extent that those conditions do not directly conflict with your rights granted under Accreditation.
- 14. You agree to treat all FFA and Venue staff (including security personnel) with respect and courtesy at all times.

### **Integrity**

- 15. You must, to the extent applicable to you, comply with all terms of FFA's Mobile and Communication Devices Policy, as amended from time to time.
- 16. You must not use any information obtained as a result of your Accreditation for the purpose of anyone betting on, or in relation to, any Match or in any other way which may amount to a breach of FFA's National Code of Conduct.

### **Replacement, suspension or cancellation**

- 17. Lost or stolen Accreditation must be immediately reported to FFA in writing. FFA may, in its absolute discretion, issue replacement Accreditation and charge a replacement fee.
- 18. A breach of this Agreement may result in your Accreditation being suspended or revoked and you being evicted from the Venue.
- 19. The suspension or revocation of Accreditation by FFA and your eviction from the Venue, is without prejudice to any other rights or remedies that FFA may have against you or your Club, Team or any organisation that you represent. Suspension, revocation and eviction may also impact on rights to accreditation for you and your Club, Team or organisation at future FFA events and matches.

### **Liability**

- 20. You agree:
  - (a) that your movement in and around the Venue is at your own risk;
  - (b) not to bring any claim or proceeding against FFA for any damage, loss, injury or liability you may suffer in accessing the Venue or carrying out your duties; and
  - (c) to safeguard your equipment or property (including personal property such as bags and money) and acknowledge that FFA is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property.
- 21. FFA:
  - (a) is not liable to you for any loss or damage you suffer as a result of the Match being cancelled, postponed or changed;

- (b) disclaims the existence of any common law duty of care to you and any holder of the ticket; and
- (c) will not replace your ticket (if applicable) if it is lost, stolen, forgotten, damaged, forged or unreadable (unless, at FFA's discretion, you can demonstrate proof of purchase and identity acceptable to FFA).

#### **Prohibition on film or recording**

- 22. From two hours before the start of the Match until one (1) hour after the end of the Match, only the Host Broadcaster of the Match (and other FFA approved rights holding broadcasters) is allowed to film or record any vision inside the Venue (including in the dressing rooms and on the field of play).

#### **Privacy**

- 23. The personal information that FFA collects on the Form is used for the purpose of processing your request for accreditation. You may request access to personal information FFA holds about you by sending an email to [privacy@ffa.com.au](mailto:privacy@ffa.com.au). - 24. You acknowledge that you may be filmed or recorded while in the Venue and that you will not make any claim against FFA for the use of your name, voice, image and/or likeness in association with such film or recording.

#### **General**

- 25. FFA may choose not to enforce a term of this Agreement in some cases in its absolute discretion without affecting its right to enforce that term in other cases or its right to enforce other terms of this Agreement.
- 26. The dates, times, participating teams and the Venue of the Match may change without notice to you.
- 27. This Agreement is governed by the law applicable in the State of New South Wales and each party submits to the jurisdiction of the courts of that state.

**SCHEDULE**  
**ACCREDITATION ZONES**

Accreditation Zones will be used at all Venues and will be enforced no less than two (2) hours prior to commencement of the Match.

The following table provides a description of the Accreditation Zone codes that appear on your Accreditation pass together with detail on the areas within a Venue which are included in each Accreditation Zone:

<b>C</b>	Team Change Rooms & Player Zones	Team Change Rooms Tunnel Warm up Area (if not FOP) Medical Room Doping Control Technical Area Coaches box
<b>M</b>	Media & Photography Areas	Media Tribune Radio Boxes Press Conference Room Mixed Zone Photographers' Room
