2023 FIFA Women's World Cup Bid – Technical Report

The purpose of this circular is to provide an update to the members of Football Federation Australia (FFA) on the status of our joint bid with New Zealand Football (NZF) to host the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup™.

As you are aware, our 'As One' bid is one of three remaining bids following Brazil's withdrawal earlier this week. In the lead up to the formal announcement of the successful bid and in accordance with its new processes, FIFA has now published its Technical report of all current bids, which includes an assessment of a range of criteria from the inspections conducted earlier this year.

It is pleasing to note that our 'As One' joint bid has scored extremely well across all criteria particularly because of the strong support of the Federal Government and the State Governments of New South Wales, Victoria, Tasmania, South Australia, Western Australia and Queensland.

The formal decision on the successful bid will be made by the FIFA Council on 25 June 2020.

We thank and congratulate Bid General Manager, Jane Fernandez, and her team on this wonderful achievement.
